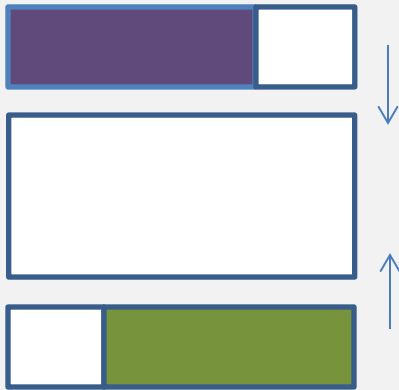
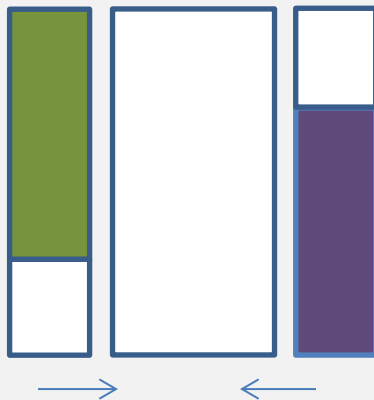


Mystery Quilt 2018 – Beginner - Clue 4

Clue 4



Clue 4, **Block-B**: Assemble 12.



Clue 4, **Block-C**: Assemble 9

*Clue 4

1. Gather 12 of the Units 3 and 4 completed in Clue 3, and twelve $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ background rectangles.
2. Assemble 12 blocks as shown. Pay close attention to the position of each unit. Make sure Unit 4 is on the top, with the coordinate-B rectangle on the left of the strip. Make sure Unit 3 is on the bottom, with the coordinate-A rectangle on the right of the strip.

Press the seam allowances toward the background rectangle. See pressing arrows. Measure $8\frac{1}{2}''$ square. Make 12 blocks.

This is **Block-B**.

3. Gather the remaining nine Units 3 and 4 completed in Clue 3, and nine $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 8\frac{1}{2}''$ background rectangles.

4. Assemble 9 blocks as shown. Pay close attention to the position of each unit. Make sure Unit 3 is on the left, with the coordinate-A rectangle on the top of the strip. Make sure Unit 4 is on the right, with the coordinate-B rectangle on the bottom of the strip.

Press the seam allowances toward the background rectangle. See pressing arrows. Measure $8\frac{1}{2}''$ square. Make 9 blocks.

This is **Block-C**.
